Statute No. 30

FEES STATUTE



Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the Fees Statute 1995.

Repeal

2. The Fees Statute (Statute No.8 of the Canberra College of Advanced Education) is repealed.

Interpretation

- 3. In this Statute, unless the contrary intention appears:
- "fees" means:
 - (a) fees referred to in section 13 of the Funding Act; or
 - (b) any fees or contributions excluded from the definition of "fees" in section 3 of the Funding Act;

"Funding Act" means the Higher Education Funding Act 1988.

Rules

4. The Council may make rules, not inconsistent with the Act or a Statute, with respect to the payment to the University of fees.
